Who is Global Legal Entity Identifier Foundation (GLEIF)

- GLEIF is a not-for-profit Swiss foundation, founded by the Financial Stability Board (FSB)
- Overseen by the Regulatory Oversight Committee
 - 71 regulators and 19 observers from 50 countries
- GLEIF Board has 18 independent directors
- 38 LEI Issuing Organizations
- > 2.7 million issued LEIs to date





The Legal Entity Identifier (ISO 17442)

A life-long Identifier Owned by the Respective Legal Entity

LEI & vLEI: Secure digital counterpart of the LEI - a digitally trustworthy version of the 20-digit LEI code which is automatically verified

The Global LEI System is the only regulatory mandated ID management system for legal entities globally.









 European Union's IPR enables PSPs to utilize LEI to verify beneficiaries for instant EUR credit transfers

A Groundswell of Stakeholder Advocacy

FATF

FATF's Revision of R.16 proposes the use

of legal identifiers like the LEI in crossborder payments in its recently launched consultation to address changes in payment models and standards (February 2024, not yet concluded)

BIS - Committee on Payments and Market Infrastructures (CPMI)

BIS

supported the LEI as an equivalent identifier to the BIC

(October 2023, Harmonized ISO 20022 data requirements)

FSB's Recommendation 6 suggests the increased use of standardized global identifiers like the LEI in cross-border payments in its latest consultation report (July 2024, notyetconcluded)




